# INFORMATION BULLETIN Nº 3

The National Research Nuclear University "MEPHI" is a leading educational establishment of the Russian Federation in personnel training for countries embarking on the path of nuclear power development or expanding their national nuclear programs.

At present, in addition to students from countries with advanced structures for training specialists and developing nuclear science, MEPhI provides educational services to more then 1,000 foreign students from Vietnam, Turkey, Bangladesh and other countries oriented towards Russian nuclear technologies.

The timeliness of the upcoming conference is determined by a number of recent events that may be of great importance for domestic nuclear power, namely: the successful commissioning in February, 2017, of Unit-1 at the Novovoronezh NPP-2 with VVER-1200 reactor (the Generation 3+ Unit was named amoung the three best nuclear installations in the world); the intergovernmental agreement between Russia and Turkey on cooperation in constructing and operating four power units with VVER-1200 reactors on Akkuyu NPP; the entry-into-force agreements on commercial contracts for constructing the El Dabaa (Egypt) signed on December 11,2017, in Cairo, in the presence of the President of the Russian Federation V.V. Putin and the President of the Arab Republic of Egypt A. Fattah el-Sisi; as well as the program for cooperation in the peaceful uses of nuclear energy, according to which Russia and Saudi Arabia intend to cooperate in the field of constructing small and medium power reactors to be used for both in Russia and in countries, where personel training is planned for their national nuclear programs and development of nuclear infrastructures. In the next few years, hundreds of students will be send to Russia for training in nuclear specialities.

The XV International Conference "NPP Safety and Personnel Training" will be traditionally held in Obninsk from November 26 to 28, 2018. The Conference "NPP Safety and Personnel Training" is unique in that it discusses the issues of safety and sustainable development of nuclear technologies in terms of the quality of personnel training and the increasing of necessary technical competencies.
